


Carol Purnell has lived in Selsey since 2001, having worked in IT management for 28 years, in UK, Germany, Italy and USA.

Fly tipping, Litter and Recycling

Environment

Carol chairs the Manhood Peninsula Partnership which includes the Environment Agency, CDC, Manhood Parishes, Chichester Harbour, RSPB, WSCC, Manhood Wildlife and Heritage, to work towards protecting our local environment and improving tourism. West Sussex CC supported the setting up of the Selsey Local Flood Actions Group (FLAGS) with funding from Operation Watershed

Better Transport Links

Selsey is at the end of the peninsula, and Carol will be encouraging improved transport links. She worked with the Neighbourhood Plan Group to negotiate land for widening of Ferry Bend and for a cycle route from Selsey to Ferry Bend.

Protecting our Fishing Industry

Selseys' fishing industry is vital to our local economy and Carol will work in partnership with CDC and Selsey Town Council Haven to see if this exciting project can come to fruition.

Community Spirit
