


Jamie has always, and will always, fight for local issues with a local voice.

Operation Watershed

West Sussex County Council's Operation Watershed has invested in key elements of flood prevention in Chichester South Division. Work here has cleared and maintained key drainage systems that keep you and your homes safe from flooding with continued investment in the project planned to ensure your continued protection.



Local Investment

The Big Society Fund has secured funding of up to £25,000 in our area. An example of how the funding is being used is at Christ Church Chichester where the funding has expanded the 'Look and See' community project. Projects like these enable our community to provide vital help and support to those most in need.

Safe Crossings

The County Local Committee has secured and committed key funding for a development of a safer pedestrian crossing on Whyke Road. The Conservative run Council is committed to maintaining and improving safe road crossings for pedestrians, keeping you and your children safe.
