FLOODING

Over the last four years Simon has secured, and delivered, over £50,000 in Operation Watershed grant-funded works. He made the case for more work by Highways to repair and restore drainage infrastructure. We need well maintained and improved drainage systems to meet the challenges of climate change.

TRANSPORT

Simon fully supports the City Road Space Audit process, seeking a comprehensive solution to our parking issues. Simon is committed to investment in Cycleways. On the A27, he will continue to campaign for a long-term solution, offering maximum value to the taxpayer. Alongside this, he supports additional investment in our local roads to maintain access to services and improve pedestrian safety.

NEW DEVELOPMENT
